

Canoe & Kayak Trip Directions

To: Coastal Kayak in Fenwick, DE

For: Trails to Rails

Meet at Coastal Kayak located directly on Rt.1 (Coastal Hwy.) in Fenwick, DE. Coastal Kayak is about 2 miles North of Rt. 54 and about 5 miles south of Rt. 26. We are located on the west side of the highway all by our selves. We have a large Coastal Kayak sign.

To: Chesapeake Bay Environmental Center (CBEC) near Grasonville, MD

For: Marsh Birds of Marshy Creek

The Chesapeake Bay Environmental Center is located 10 minutes east of the Bay Bridge off Rt. 50 in Grasonville. From the East take Exit 44A. For the West take Exit 43B. Follow the brown and white signs to the entrance road.

To: Tuckahoe State Park near Queen Anne, MD

For: Neotropicals Along the Tuckahoe

Tuckahoe State Park is located approximately 35 miles east of the Bay Bridge, just off MD Rt. 404, on Maryland's Eastern Shore. Travel east on Rt. 50/301 across the Bay Bridge. Rt. 50/301 splits, bear to the right on Rt. 50. Make a left at the intersection of Rt. 50 and Rt. 404. Go approximately 8 miles until you come to the intersection of Rt. 404 and Rt. 480. Make a left on Rt. 480. To your immediate left take Eveland Road. Once on Eveland Road follow directional signs.

To: Pocomoke River Canoe Company in Snow Hill, MD

For: Prothonotary Paddle, Warblers on Water and Moonlight Marsh Paddle

From Ocean City: Take Rt. 50 West to Rt. 113 South or Rt. 90 West to Rt. 113 South. Follow Rt. 113 South approximately 17 miles to the exit for Snow Hill. Exit right onto Business Rt. 113 into Snow Hill to the traffic light (there's only one). Turn right at the light onto Rt. 12 (Washington Street). Follow Rt. 12 for 2 blocks. Pocomoke River Canoe Company is on the right next to the Pocomoke River Bridge.

From Points West and North: From Rt. 50, take Rt. 13 South to Md. Rt. 12. Exit on Rt. 12 and take a left. The sign will indicate direction to Snow Hill. Stay on Rt. 12 all the way into Snow Hill. The Pocomoke River Canoe Company is on the left next to the Pocomoke River Bridge.

To:	<u>King's Creek near Princess Anne, MD</u>
For:	Kingfishers on King's Creek – PLEASE NOTE: this trip is held on private property, and is not accessible to the general public

From the North: Take Route 13 South through Princess Anne (2 traffic lights). Turn right on Stewart Neck Road (just south of the second light look for the Somerset Animal Hospital). Go approximately ¼ mile and turn right onto Hayman Road. Just past the church there is a dirt road by a tall wooden fence. Signs will be out on the day of the event. Turn left and follow the road to the river.

From the South: Take Route 13 North towards Princess Anne. Watch for the Econo Lodge and the State Highway Administration. Just past those locations, turn left onto Stewart Neck Road. Go approximately ¼ mile and turn right onto Hayman Road. Just past the church there is a dirt road by a tall wooden fence. Signs will be out on the day of the event. Turn left and follow the road to the river.

To:	<u>Prime Hook State Boat Ramp near Milton, DE</u>
For:	Paddling Prime Hook

From Rte. 1: Turn onto Road 38/Prime Hook Road (from the north, turn left - from the south, turn right). The turn will be marked with a brown sign for Prime Hook National Wildlife Refuge. The road will fork, stay to the right on Road 38/Prime Hook Road. Very soon, make a right turn onto Little Neck Road and follow this all the way to the end where there will be parking - this is the paddling rally point.

There are no bathrooms or other facilities here. Please bring bug spray and plenty of water. We will be using the State of Delaware access to Prime Hook, NOT the Prime Hook National Wildlife Refuge boat ramp.

To:	<u>James Farm Ecological Preserve</u>
For:	Paddling the James Farm Preserve

From the intersection of Routes 1 & 26 in Bethany Beach, go north on 1 for 1.2 miles, then turn left on Fred Hudson Road, which ends in 1.3 miles at Cedar Neck Road (Road 357). Turn right on Cedar Neck Road, and go another 1.3 miles. The parking lot for the James Farm is on the left.

To:	<u>Ayers Creek Adventures</u>
For:	Ayers Creek Sunrise Paddle, Ayers and Trappe Creek Saltwater Marsh Paddle, Ayers and Trappe Creek Sunset Paddle

From Ocean City take Rt 50 (Ocean Gateway) West to Rt 611 (Stephen Decatur Highway) south. Go approx 4 miles and make a right on Rt 376 (Assateague Road). Go approx 0.8 miles make the first right immediately over the Ayers Creek bridge onto Grey Fox Lane. From East bound Rt 50 (Ocean Gateway), take Rt 113 South (Worcester Hwy) approx 0.4 miles. Turn left on Rt 376 (Assateague Road). Go approx 3.2 miles and turn left onto Grey Fox Lane, just before the Ayers Creek bridge.

Parking is adjacent to and in front of the warehouse, second building on the left.

To: Castaways Campground

For: Castaways Campground Salt Marsh Exploration, Castaways Campground Sunset Paddle

From Rt 50 (Ocean Gateway) take Rt 611 (Stephen Decatur Highway) south. Go 2.3 miles and make a left on Eagles Next Road. Go approx 1.3 miles to Castaways Campground.

To: Buck's Place

For: Kayak Assateague at Sunset, Wildlife Discovery Tour

From Ocean City take Rt 50 (Ocean Gateway) West to Rt 611 (Stephen Decatur Highway) south. Go approx 4 miles and make a right into Buck's Place parking lot just after Rt 376 (Assateague Road). From East bound Rt 50 (Ocean Gateway), take Rt 113 South (Worcester Hwy) approx 0.4 miles. Turn left on Rt 376 (Assateague Road). Go approx 3.4 miles and turn right into Buck's Place parking lot, just before Rt. 611.

To: Whitehaven Hotel Bed & Breakfast

For: Heron Rookery Paddle

From Route 50 Traveling East (From Northern Virginia/Baltimore/Washington, D.C.): When heading East on Rt. 50, proceed through Mardela. Before Salisbury, turn right on Rockawalkin Road, continue about 3 miles and turn right onto Nanticoke Road. Continue 5 miles and turn left on Whitehaven Road, continue 7.5 miles. This road ends at the Whitehaven Ferry and Whitehaven Hotel Bed & Breakfast.

#### Boat Excursion Trip Directions

To: Cape May-Lewes Ferry Terminal near Lewes, DE

For: Poor Man's Pelagic on the Cape-May Lewes Ferry

From Rehoboth Beach, DE: take Route 1 North past Rehoboth Outlets to Route 9 East

From Ocean City, MD: take Route 1 North to Route 9 East.

From Easton, MD: take Route 331 South from Easton to Route 318 East; Routes 331 and 318 will intersect, follow 318 East to Route 18 East; in Georgetown, Delaware, take Route 9 East.

From Baltimore, MD: take Route 97 South to Route 50 East over the William Preston Lake Jr.

Memorial Bridge to Route 404 East to Georgetown, Delaware, to Route 9 East.

From Washington, DC: take Route 495 North/South around city to Route 50 East, then follow Baltimore directions.

To: Lil' Angler II Charter Boat in Lewes, DE

For: Birding on the Broadkill

From Rehoboth, Dewey, Bethany, Fenwick, (coming RT 1 North): Follow RT 1 North (you will pass The Delaware State Police Barracks and Lowe's on the left. Lewes Auto Mall on the right). After the Texaco Station turn right at the light onto Business RT 9. Follow Business RT 9 into the heart of Lewes, cross the drawbridge and turn left onto Anglers Road, go 300 yards to large blue sign "Fishing".

From the North - Milford, Dover (coming RT 1 South): Follow RT 1 South. You will pass Nassau Orchards, and go over an overpass. Get in the left lane. Turn left at the light onto \*Business RT 9. Follow \*Business RT 9 into the heart of Lewes, cross the drawbridge and turn left onto Anglers Road, go 300 yards to large blue sign "Fishing".

From Wilmington, Philadelphia: Follow 195 South to RT 141 to RT 13 South to RT 1 (bypass) to RT 113 South to RT 1 (again). Then follow directions.

From Baltimore/Washington D.C., Annapolis: Follow RT 50 East, the Chesapeake Bay Bridge, to 404 East. Follow To Georgetown, Delaware, go 3/4 around the circle in Georgetown. Signs are well-marked and labeled "beaches". Hint: FROM THIS POINT YOU DO NOT MAKE ANY TURN UNTIL YOU TURN ONTO "ANGLERS ROAD". From the circle in Georgetown, continue following RT 404 East for about 9 miles. You'll come to a large lighted intersection call 5 Points. Here RT 404 ends. Continue straight thru the lights onto \*Business RT 9 into the heart of Lewes, cross the drawbridge and turn left onto Anglers Road, go 300 yards to large blue sign "Fishing".

\*We stress BUSINESS RT 9 not RT 9.

To: Fisherman's Crab Deck in the Kent Narrows, MD

For: Bay Birds of the Kent Narrows

U.S. Route 50 Eastbound: Traveling eastbound, cross the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and continue on US Rt. 50/301 about 6 miles, Exit 42/Kent Narrows, right at stop sign, cross Kent Narrows Draw Bridge.

U.S. Route 50 Westbound: Traveling westbound US Rt.50/301, Exit 42/Kent Narrows left at stop sign. Continue under the bridge.

To: Phillips Wharf Environmental Center on Tilghman Island, MD

For: Circumnavigate Tilghman Island

From Easton, MD, take Rt. 33 through St. Michaels, continue on to Tilghman Island. After crossing the Knapp's Narrows Bridge, turn left onto Chicken Point Road. Turn left into parking lot for Phillips Wharf.

To:	<u>Shorebird Explorer/Talbot Street Water Sports in Ocean City, MD</u>
For:	Shorebird Explorer

The boat dock is at the Talbot Street Pier in downtown Ocean City, 1 block south of the Rt. 50 Bridge on the bay side.

To:	<u>Somers Cove Marina in Crisfield, MD</u>
For:	The Nature of Smith Island

From the North: Take Rt. 13 South to Rt. 413. Bear right onto Rt. 413 and follow into Crisfield (Rt. 413 will split in to a dual highway). Make a left onto 7<sup>th</sup> Street (note: Paddlewheel Motel is on the left and there will be signs for Somers Cove Marina and Charter Fishing Center). You're almost there, only 7/10 of a mile to go. Follow 7<sup>th</sup> Street and go past the entrance to Somers Cove Marina. The road curves to the left (you will pass the Community Center on the left). Continue to the stop sign. Make a right at the stop sign (this is Norris Harbor Drive, but road signs have a short life span here) and follow the road to the right. Follow directional signs to the Charter Fishing Center. It is located on the right (opposite side of the Marina). You may park here and board the boat at Pier N.

From the South: Take Rt. 13 North to Rt. 667. Make a left onto Rt. 667. Follow Rt. 667 to Rt. 413 and follow into Crisfield. (Rt. 413 will split in to a dual highway). Make a left onto 7<sup>th</sup> Street (note: Paddlewheel Motel is on the left and there will be signs for Somers Cove Marina and Charter Fishing Center). You're almost there, only 7/10 of a mile to go. Follow 7<sup>th</sup> Street and go past the entrance to Somers Cove Marina. The road curves to the left (you will pass the Community Center on the left). Continue to the stop sign. Make a right at the stop sign (this is Norris Harbor Drive, but road signs have a short life span here) and follow the road to the right. Follow directional signs to the Charter Fishing Center. It is located on the right (opposite side of the Marina). You may park here and board the boat at Pier N.

To:	<u>Delmarva Discovery Center in Pocomoke, MD</u>
For:	Pocomoke River Boat Trip

From Route 13: Turn onto business 13, which becomes Market Street in Pocomoke. The Delmarva Discovery Center is on the south side of the road, just east of the drawbridge.

Night Life Trip Directions

To: Chesapeake Bay Environmental Center (CBEC) near Grasonville, MD

For: Chesapeake Hoots

The Chesapeake Bay Environmental Center is located 10 minutes east of the Bay Bridge off Rt. 50 in Grasonville. From the East take Exit 44A. For the West take Exit 43B. Follow the brown and white signs to the entrance road.

To: Pickering Creek Audubon Center near Easton, MD

For: Owl Prowl at Pickering Creek Audubon Center

Directions from Baltimore:

Take I-97 to Route 50/301 in Annapolis. Take Route 50 East over Bay Bridge, and continue towards Easton. Pass by Routes 213 and 404. At mile marker 58 turn right onto 662 (route 662 crosses Route 50 a couple times, so make sure you turn at mile marker 58). Follow 662 through the town of Longwoods, past a red schoolhouse, and turn right onto Sharp Road (the first turn after Rabbit Hill Road, which is on the left). Follow Sharp Road for 1.5 miles. Turn right onto the continuation of Sharp Road (there's a sign there for Sharp Road to Presquile Road) and follow for 1.25 miles. A Pickering Creek Audubon Center sign is on the right hand side. Turn right and follow the gravel driveway until the first turn. The welcome center is in front of you and parking is to the left.

From south of Easton:

Take Route 50 north towards Easton. At the Municipal Airport, turn left onto Airport Road and take the immediate right hand turn onto 662 or Longwoods Road. After a small bridge, turn left onto Sharp Road. Follow Sharp Road for 1.5 miles. Turn right onto the continuation of Sharp Road (Sharp Road to Presquile Road) and follow for 1.25 miles. A Pickering Creek Audubon Center sign is on the right hand side. Turn right and follow the gravel driveway until the first turn. The welcome center is in front of you and parking is to the left.

To: Snow Hill Library in Snow Hill, MD

For: Night Birds of the Marsh

From Ocean City: Take Rt. 50 West to Rt. 113 South or Rt. 90 West to Rt. 113 South. Follow Rt. 113 South for approximately 17 miles to the exit for Snow Hill. Exit on Business Rt. 113 into Snow Hill to the traffic light. Turn right at the light onto Rt. 12 (Washington Street). Follow 2 blocks to Willow Street or River Street (both left-hand turns). You will pass the Library on the left. Parking is available behind or next to the Library off either of these streets.

From Points North & West: Take Rt. 50 East to Rt. 13 South to Md Rt. 12. Exit on Rt. 12 and take a left. Sign will indicate direction to Snow Hill. Stay on Rt. 12 all the way into Snow Hill. The Library is just past the Pocomoke River Bridge on the right. Turn left on River Street or Willow Street to park.

To: Assateague Island National Seashore

For: Assateague at Dusk

From Ocean City: Take Rt. 50 West to Rt. 611. Follow Rt. 611 onto Assateague Island. Follow signs for the National Seashore. After passing through fee collection booth, proceed to the last parking lot (the road will dead end). Guide will meet you in the parking lot.

From Ocean City (N): Take Rt. 90 West to Rt. 113 South. Follow to Rt. 376 East. You will see signs at the traffic light for Rt. 611. Follow until the road ends and turn right onto Rt. 611. Follow signs for the National Seashore. After passing through fee collection booth, proceed to the last parking lot (the road will dead end). Guide will meet you in the parking lot.

From Points West: Take Rt. 50 East to Rt. 707 (just before Ocean City) Turn right onto Rt. 707 to Rt. 611. Turn right and follow Rt. 611 onto Assateague Island. Follow signs for the National Seashore. After passing through fee collection booth, proceed to the last parking lot (the road will dead end). Guide will meet you in the parking lot.

To: Pemberton Historical Park near Salisbury, MD

For: Owl Prowl at Pemberton

From Ocean City: Follow Rt. 50 West through Salisbury to Rt. 349 (Nanticoke Road). Turn left onto Nanticoke Road. Take the next immediate left onto Pemberton Drive. After passing Shore Stop and Domino's Pizza, it's approximately another 2 miles. Pemberton Park is on the left. You will see a small sign identifying the park on the left. Follow the road to the end and meet the guide at the parking lot.

From Points West: Follow Rt. 50 East towards Salisbury to Rt. 349 (Nanticoke Road). Turn right onto Nanticoke Road. Take the next immediate left onto Pemberton Drive. After passing Shore Stop and Domino's Pizza, it's approximately another 2 miles. Pemberton Park is on the left. You will see a small sign identifying the park on the left. Follow the road to the end and meet the guide at the parking lot.

#### Day Trek Trip Directions

To: Bombay Hook National Wildlife Refuge near Leipsic, De

For: Birds of the Bombay Hook

From the North - Philadelphia Area: Take I-95 South into Delaware. Take Route 1 South (Christiana exit - toll road \$1.00). From Route 1 South take exit 114 (Smyrna- South exit). RT 13 North will be a right turn at the end of the exit ramp at a traffic light. Turn right at the next light on to Road 12 East (Smyrna-Leipsic Road). This road merges with Route 9 South (5 miles). Turn left onto Whitehall Neck Road, which ends at the Refuge entrance.

From the South - Washington, DC Area: Take I-95 North to Washington, DC Beltway. Take Route 50 East over the Chesapeake Bay Bridge. Take 301 North. Take Route 300 East to Smyrna. Take Route 13

South. Turn left on Route 12 East (Smyrna-Leipsic Road) and proceed until it merges with Route 9 (5 miles). Stay on Route 9 south. Turn left on Whitehall Neck Road, which ends at the Refuge entrance. From Dover, Delaware: Take Route 13 North. Turn right onto Route 42 East into Leipsic. Turn left onto Route 9 and proceed north for 2 miles. Turn right onto Whitehall Neck Road, which ends at the Refuge entrance.

To:	<u>DuPont Nature Center at the Mispillion Harbor Reserve near Milford, DE</u>
For:	<u>DuPont Nature Center at the Mispillion Harbor Reserve</u>

From the North (Wilmington / Dover): Take Route 1 south to exit SR-36 toward Milford/Slaughter Beach. Turn left onto Cedar Beach Road / DE-36 (4.6 miles). Turn left onto Lighthouse Road (1 mile). From the South (beaches): Take Route 1 north to exit SR-36 toward Milford / Slaughter Beach. Turn right onto Cedar Beach Road / DE-36 (4.6 miles). Turn left onto Lighthouse Road (1 mile).

To:	<u>Terrapin Park Nature Area near Stevensville, MD</u>
For:	Chesapeake Beach Birding

From Rt. 50/301, take Exit 37 to North Rt. 8 to Log Canoe Circle, turn left, continue to parking area on left.

To:	<u>Cape Henlopen State Park – Seaside Nature Center near Lewes, DE</u>
For:	Cape Birding Escape

From the South: Take either Rt. 13 or Rt. 113 North, then Rt. 9 to Lewes. At the intersection with Rt. 1, turn right (south on Rt. 1). Follow signs for Cape May Ferry & Cape Henlopen State Park, taking Rt. 9 (not Rt. 9 Business). Make a left at the light after the State Police Office. Once at the ferry, continue down Cape Henlopen Drive following brown signs to the Park. Once inside Cape Henlopen State Park, go through the fee booth, follow signs for Seaside Nature Center (left immediately after the fee booth). Take a left again at the intersection, follow the road to the right, then the second left into the Nature Center parking lot. The guide will meet you.

From the North: Take Rt. 1 South to Lewes, Rehoboth Beach. Follow signs for Cape May Ferry & Cape Henlopen State Park (Rt. 9 East). Make a left at the light after the State Police Office. Once inside Cape Henlopen State Park, go through the fee booth, follow signs for Seaside Nature Center (left immediately after the fee booth). Take a left again at the intersection, follow the road to the right, then the second left into Nature Center parking lot. The guide will meet you.

To: The Rookery Golf Course near Milton, DE

For: Birds of the Delaware Bay Coast

Meet at the entrance to the Rookery Golf Course, 3 miles east of Milton, Delaware. The Rookery's street address is 27052 Broadkill Road, Milton, Delaware. Their web site is:

Enter the Rookery Golf Course by turning right from Broadkill Road (Rt. 16) just 100 yards east of the intersection of Coastal Highway (Rt. 1) and Broadkill Road (Rt. 16). The intersection of Rts. 1 and 16 is approximately 7 miles north of Lewes, Delaware (or 9 miles north of Rehoboth) on Coastal Highway (Rt. 1).

To: Delmarva Discovery Center in Pocomoke, MD

For: Wings Over Williams Point

From Route 13: Turn onto business 13, which becomes Market Street in Pocomoke. The Delmarva Discovery Center is on the south side of the road, just east of the drawbridge.

To: Pemberton Historical Park near Salisbury, MD

For: Eagles and Others

From Ocean City: Follow Rt. 50 West through Salisbury to Rt. 349 (Nanticoke Road). Turn left onto Nanticoke Road. Take the next immediate left onto Pemberton Drive. After passing Shore Stop and Domino's Pizza, it's approximately another 2 miles. Pemberton Park is on the left. You will see a small sign identifying the park on the left. Follow the road to the end and meet the guide at the parking lot.

From Points West: Follow Rt. 50 East towards Salisbury to Rt. 349 (Nanticoke Road). Turn right onto Nanticoke Road. Take the next immediate left onto Pemberton Drive. From Ocean City (north): Take Rt. 90 West to Rt. 113 South. Follow to Rt. 376 East. You will see signs at the traffic light for Rt. 611. Follow until the road ends and turn right onto Rt. 611. Follow signs for the National Seashore. After passing through fee collection booth, proceed to the last parking lot (the road will dead end). Guide will meet you in the parking lot.

From Points West: Take Rt. 50 East to Rt. 707 (just before Ocean City) Turn right onto Rt. 707 to Rt. 611. Turn right and follow Rt. 611 onto Assateague Island. Follow signs for the National Seashore. After passing through fee collection booth, proceed to the last parking lot (the road will dead end). Guide will meet you in the parking lot.

To:	<u>Newport Farms near Berlin, MD</u>
For:	Newport Farms Diversity Walk – PLEASE NOTE: this trip is held on private property, and is not accessible to the general public

From Ocean City: Take Rt. 50 West or Rt. 90 West to Rt. 113 South. About 2 miles south of Berlin, turn left on Hayes Landing Road and follow to the end of the road. STOP at the circle at the end of the road and park in the cul-de-sac. A guide will meet you there.  
From the South: Take Rt. 113 North towards Berlin. Turn right on Hayes Landing Road and follow to the end of the road. STOP at the circle at the end of the road and park in the cul-de-sac. A guide will meet you there.

To:	<u>Ward Museum of Wildfowl Art in Salisbury, MD</u>
For:	Warblermania!

From Ocean City: Take Rt. 50 West (Business) or Rt. 90 West to Rt. 50. Follow Rt. 50 approximately 28 miles to Salisbury to Beaglin Park Drive. Turn left on Beaglin Park Drive. Proceed through 3 intersections. Turn left at the 4<sup>th</sup> light onto Schumaker Drive. The Ward Museum entrance is on the left.  
From Points West: Follow Rt. 50 East (business) through Salisbury to Beaglin Park Drive. Turn right on Beaglin Park Drive. Proceed through 3 intersections. Turn left at the 4<sup>th</sup> light onto Schumaker Drive. The Ward Museum entrance is on the left.  
From Points North & South: Take Rt. 13 to Rt. 50 (Salisbury Business Exit). Follow Rt. 50 for a short distance to Beaglin Park Drive. Turn left on Beaglin Park Drive. Proceed through 3 intersections. Turn left at the 4<sup>th</sup> light onto Schumaker Drive. The Ward Museum entrance is on the left.

To:	<u>Quiet Resorts Visitor Center (back parking lot) in Fenwick, DE</u>
For:	Delaware’s Coastal Birding Delights

From Ocean City: Head North on Coastal Highway (which becomes Rt. 1) towards Fenwick-Bethany Beach, Delaware. The Visitor Center is on the right hand side (oceanside) in Fenwick approximately 1 mile after you come into Delaware. You will see a sign for “Quiet Resorts Visitor Center”. You will meet in the back parking lot to carpool to the birding site.  
From Baltimore/Washington/Northern Virginia Area: Take Rt. 50 East across the Bay Bridge. Continue on Rt. 50 to the Rt. 404 intersection and turn left. Stay on Rt. 404 until Bridgeville, DE. Rt. 404 becomes Rt. 18 at Bridgeville. Stay on Rt. 18 to Rt. 113 at Georgetown, DE. Rt. 113 South to Rt. 26-East on Rt. 26 to Rt. 1 at Bethany Beach. Follow Rt. 1 to Fenwick Island. The Quiet Resorts Visitor Center will be on your left.

From New York, New Jersey, Philadelphia/Wilmington Area: Take I-95 South to Exit 4. Follow Rt. 1 South (Rt. 1 is under construction and will become Rt. 13 and Rt. 113 at times). Continue following the highway signs for Rt. 1 South until you reach Bethany Beach. Follow Rt. 1 to Fenwick Island. The Quiet Resorts Visitor Center will be on your left.
